



KZIA Contest Rules

Cedar Rapids Opera “Die Fledermaus” Ticket Giveaway

- 1) No purchase is necessary to enter the contest and claim prizes.
- 2) CONTEST DATES: **Monday, Dec. 15, 2025, at 6 a.m. to Friday, Dec. 19, 2025, at 10 a.m.**
- 3) CONDITION OF PARTICIPATION: Materials submitted become property of KZIA, Inc. Winner may be required to execute an affidavit of eligibility and name and likeness publicity release and a waiver and release of liability. By participating in this contest, participants agree to be bound by these rules. The decision(s) of judges provided by KZIA, Inc., will be final. All taxes and any registration fees or deposits are the sole responsibility of the verified winner. If the prize includes travel with a traveling companion, the traveling companion must also be age 18 or older and complete the waiver and release of liability form and the name and likeness publicity release.
- 4) ELIGIBILITY: Participation for the prize is open to any individual age 18 (calculated from documental date of birth) or older, EXCEPT: employees of KZIA, Inc.; persons with a family relationship to those employees (spouse, parent/child, sibling or in-law relationship); owners and or management level employees of advertising agencies in this contest, if applicable; employees of advertising agencies representing sponsors in this contest, if applicable, and employees of the advertising sponsors in this contest, and persons with a family relationship to employees of advertising sponsors in this contest, if applicable. Two tickets to see a Cedar Rapids Opera performance of “Die Fledermaus” on Jan. 16, 2026, at 7:30 p.m. or on Jan. 18, 2026, at 2 p.m. Each ticket is valued at \$27.50; the total prize package is valued at \$55.
